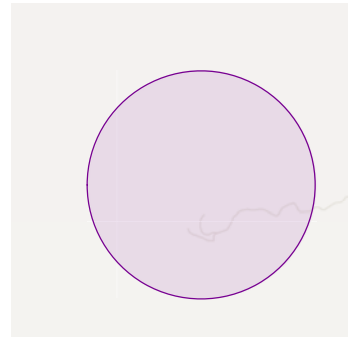
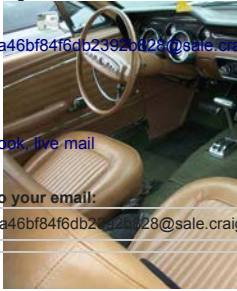

This car is a 1968 High Country Special. In 1966 and 1967 Colorado offered a High Country Special, it was one of 5 unique colors that came with a brass dealer installed tag.

In 1968 Ford decided to roll out a program car known as the CS/GT California Special & High Country Special. The difference between these two cars were just the striping kit was a little different.

The California Special was sold in Washington, Oregon, California, Nevada, and New Mexico. There were 4118 California Specials built in 1968.

The Colorado Special was sold exclusively in Colorado. There were 251 Colorado Specials built in 1968. So they are a rare car. Most people have never seen one.

All the upgrades on this car are from Shelby. The add-ons were Square Fog Laps, Hood Pins, Side Scoops, Rear Fiberglass Deck Lid and Valiance, Center Stripe Kit, and Shelby Tail Lights.
